

## conducting minor for music majors only

## Music

This sequence is for music majors who are interested in developing their conducting skills and who have leadership and organizational aptitude.

## **Admission Requirements**

- 1. The student must apply to enter the program in the office of the Director of Student Services (HOA 141) and have an interview with Daniel Curtis, the faculty supervisor of the conducting minor.
- 2. A 3.0 cumulative overall QPA and good academic standing are required for acceptance into the minor in conducting. Note that only a limited number of students can be accepted into the program.
- 3. In addition to passing the prerequisite courses listed below ...
- \* Advanced Solfege I and II with "A" or "B" grades OR Solfege I and II with "A" or "B" grades and the recommendation of the student's solfege instructor.
  - \* Introduction to Conducting with an "A" grade or with a "B" grade and the recommendation of the student's conducting instructor.

## **Academic Requirements**

- 1. Instrumental/Choral Conducting must be completed before the senior year with an "A" grade or with a "B" grade and with the recommendation of the student's conducting instructor before the student can register for the advanced conducting courses (see #2).
- 2. Conducting Practicum must be taken during the same semester as Independent Study in Conducting. Both courses must be taken after completing Introduction to Conducting and Instrumental/Choral Conducting
- 3. A 3.0 cumulative overall QPA is required for graduation with the minor in conducting.
